Privacy policy

Why we collect your data

We collect data as part of the requirement to be a member of the club. Holding this data enables us to contact you by post, email or telephone regarding matters affecting the tennis club activities and your membership.

How we collect your data

We collect data annually on membership renewal or when you first join the club. The data we hold is the information supplied on your membership application form. We take appropriate steps to protect your data and make sure it is accurate, complete and current. You can help us to do this by notifying us of any changes to your personal data when they occur.

When you cease to be a member of the club your data is no longer retained.

Sharing your data

We do not share your data with any other parties except in the following circumstances: -

Junior coaching

For the purposes of managing junior coaching, parents' telephone contact details are given to the coach to assist the coach to manage sessions.

Court Booking system

The court booking system uses an online system called Skedda. Members should be aware that when they use this system they are sharing information with a third party (Skedda). Additionally the member information stored by Skedda can be shared by them with other third parties. In order for the members to be fully aware of the position Skedda's privacy policy details are available through the link below.

Your rights

You have a number of legal rights to control what we do with your information. You are entitled to see the data we hold and obtain a copy of it (this will be the information on your annual subscription form), correct or update information that is wrong. You also have the right to have data removed. However if you decided to have some or all of your information removed it makes it difficult for the club to keep you informed. Removing all your information would effectively mean you would be unable to remain a member.
